Allocated space extends 40cms beyond the table dimensions.

Design may extend a maximum of 30cms beyond the table dimensions.

No height restriction.

Design to allow for 8 diners at the table.

No chairs will be at the table during designing or judging.

To be judged all around using FASNZ General Design Points system.

An entry can be one or two designers, both designers to be members of FASNZ and registered for the full Conference, names to be specified on the entry form.

Title: 'Beyond 25'

**Contemporary Garland** 

Garland to be 120cms in length, maximum height 30cms, maximum width 30cms.

No floral foam to be used.

Designs to be staged on provided oval table dressed in black with skirt to the floor.

May be more than one garland per table.

Judging by People's Choice, winner to be announced at Celebration dinner.

# **General Information - applicable to all classes**

#### Information:

Plant material must pre-dominate, artificial plant forms are not permitted. Waterproof covering for carpet to be provided by the designer and used during designing.

Steps may be appropriate for higher placements, note safety clause.

Use of pre-prepared components in accordance with FLAIR.

There is no storage space for replacement plant material.

There is an onsite storage space for labelled flower boxes.

A rubbish skip will be available at the service dock.

Maintenance and watering for all classes is Saturday 3 May from 8am to 9am .

#### Packing in and out

Access to the service dock and lift is from Wakefield Street. Please quickly unload and move your car to allow others to unload.

Internal access to Rongomatane level is via internal lifts and/ or escalator.

### Judging

Judging to the specified FASNZ judging system for each class, the Judges' decision is final.

#### **Pest Plant material**

No member shall knowingly display or exhibit any plant material on the NZ National Pest Plant Accord and/or Wellington Regional Council Pest Plant Management List at any public show or exhibition.

#### Photography

Photographs taken may be used for personal purposes, but may not be used for commercial purposes without the prior permission of FASNZ Inc. FASNZ reserves the right to publish any photographs of designs taken.

There is no video or motion picture approval for the event. Requests for this must be submitted to FASNZ prior to the event being subject to Takina Events approval and policies.

#### Safety

Safe and good practice is paramount while designing. By entering you are agreeing to abide by the Safety and Hazard Policy in support of the NZ Health Work Act 2015.

Take all practical steps to identify, reduce or eliminate the risk of harm to employees, contractors or members of the public in the Venue and in the Building.

Maintain clear access to fire egress routes, exits or firefighting equipment in the Venue.
