Conditions One entry per person. All must be members of an Auckland affiliated club.
Entries close Friday 28th August 2020
Mechanics such as floral foam and caging may be attached in advance.
Individual components may be prepared in advance but NO prepared components or fresh plant material to be placed prior to the start of the competition at 9.30am on 22nd September 2020.

Restrictions Painted material to be used with discretion.
NO artificial flowers or foliage permitted.
Junior and Intermediate competitors who have won first prize in their category in a previous DOY competition may not enter that category again.
No use of prohibited plant materials permitted.
